

RULES FOR ADMISSION

1.1 DOMICILE :

Orissa State Candidates (S – Domicile) :

For admission to Engineering Schools/ Polytechnics under State Domicile, a candidate has to satisfy at least one of the following 3 criteria.

- i) The Candidate must have passed or appeared 10+ examinations or its equivalent examination from any of the recognized institution in the State subsequently passed.
- ii) Parent of the candidate must be permanent resident of Orissa. To claim benefit under this class, candidate shall furnish a permanent resident certificate from a Revenue Officer not below the Rank of Tahasildar of the area where his/her parents have permanent residence in **Form-V**.
- iii) Sons/ daughters/ spouse of the permanent employees of the Government of Orissa/ Government of India/ Government of Orissa undertakings/ Government of India undertaking serving in the State of Orissa at the time of application. To claim this benefit under this **S-Domicile**, candidate has to submit a certificate from the Employer of his/her parents/spouse in the prescribed form in **Form-IV**. However candidates coming under this clause is not eligible to claim reservation unless he/she is a permanent resident of Orissa.

Outside State Candidates (OS – Domicile) :

Any candidate who does not satisfy any of the criteria for the S Domicile will be treated as outside State Candidate (OS). 15% seats are reserved for “OS” candidates in Private Polytechnics only.

Oriyas living in outlying Oriya speaking tracts (OL – Domicile) :

0.5% seats are reserved for Oriya students living in the outlying Oriya speaking tracts.

1.2. RESERVATION OF SEATS UNDER STATE DOMICILE :

- a. There are some seats as mentioned below reserved for SC/ ST/ Son & Daughter of Green Card holders/ ES/ PH/ Women/ SP/ NCC category wise as per Govt. directives from time to time.

1.	For SC	15%
2.	For ST	23%
3.	For Children of Green Card Holder	05%
4.	For Children / Wards of Ex-Servicemen	02%
5.	For Physically Handicapped	03%
6.	For Women students in all Co-education Polytechnics / Engineering Schools in each category	15%
7.	For SPORTS category (Candidates must have represented State during last two (2) years)	0.5%
8.	For NCC category (A, B or C)	01%

N.B. : In case of change in percentage / condition of reservation of seats mentioned above on the basis of order / instruction of competent authority, it will be intimated to the candidates before commencement of counseling.

- i. Reservations are available for candidates of Orissa State only. Any candidate claiming admission under these reserved categories has to produce the permanent resident certificate from the Competent Authority in Form-V.
- ii. The reservations are applicable for all seats in Government Engineering Schools / Polytechnics and 80% seats of Private Engineering Schools /Polytechnics.
- iii. No reservation of seats is available against the seats located outside the State by MHRD/ AICTE.
- iv. Reservation of seats at IGIT, Sarang & OSME, Keonjhar : 24 seats (i.e. Civil-08, Electrical-08 & Mechanical-08) at IGIT, Sarang & 16 seats in Mining Engineering at OSME, Keonjhar are reserved for the children of Coal Mines workers. Such candidates may apply directly to the **CHIEF PERSONNEL MANAGER, MAHANADI COAL FIELDS LTD., JAGRUTI BIHAR, PO-UCE BURLA, SAMBALPUR-768 018** for selection. The sponsored candidates of MCL need not appear the **DET-2011**.
- v. Reservation of seats in Textile Tech. in ITT, Choudwar: - 5 seats in Textile Technology at ITT, Choudwar are reserved for the Weavers'

Community, sponsored by Director of Textile, Orissa. Candidate with requisite qualification desirous of selection under this provision may apply directly to the Director of Textiles, Orissa, Bhubaneswar. These sponsored candidates also need not appear the DET-2011.

vi. **Women & Physically Handicapped candidates are not eligible for admission to Mining Engineering & Drilling Engineering Courses.**

vii. In the "Lateral Entry Scheme" admission shall be made as per the instruction of the State Government.

viii. The Selected Candidates other than Physically Handicapped shall have to produce a Medical Fitness Certificate from a Government Doctor not below the rank of Asst. Surgeon to the effect that the candidate is fit to prosecute studies in Engineering Schools & Polytechnics. However Government of Orissa / DET Committee will not be responsible if a candidate faces difficulty during the course of study or during employment on medical ground. A candidate intending to take admission in **HMCT** will have to furnish a separate medical fitness certificate in **Form-VI**.

ix. Candidates belonging to SC/ST (**by birth not by marriage or adoption**) reserved category shall furnish photo copies of the Caste Certificate in the proforma in **Form-I** from the competent authority at the time of submission of application form and original will be verified at the time of reporting in the Institution.

x. Scheduled Caste / Tribe persons who have migrated from the State of Origin to some other state for the purpose of seeking education, employment etc. will be deemed to be Scheduled Caste / Tribe of the State of his origin and will be entitled to derive benefits from the state of origin and not from the State to which he has migrated (Vide Govt. of India letter No. BC/16084, 1.82-SC and BCS/dated 22.02.1985).

xi. Candidates applying under Green Card reservation shall submit photocopies of the Green card along with the application form and the original Green Card shall be verified at the time of reporting at the designated institutions. The Green

card must have been issued by Family Welfare Department, Government of Orissa and should not have been used more than once prior to claiming admission under this reservation.

xii. Candidates applying under Ex-Servicemen reservation shall have to furnish photocopies of certificate in the prescribed format in **Form-II** along with the application form and original certificate shall be verified at the time of reporting in the Institution. A revised merit list will be drawn from the eligible Ex-Servicemen category candidates as per the prioritization described below vide Industries Dept. Govt. Order No.9829/I, dt.08.07.2009.

Priority-I. Children/ widows of Ex-Servicemen killed in action.

Priority-II. Children of Ex-Servicemen disabled in action.

Priority-III. Children/ widows of Ex-Servicemen who died in peace time with death attributable to military service.

Priority-IV. Children of Ex-Servicemen disabled in peace time with disability attributable to military service.

Priority-V. Children of Ex-Servicemen who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards.

Priority-VI. Children of Ex-Servicemen.

xiii. In case of Physically Handicapped candidates, Photocopies of certificate from the Chief District Medical Officer indicating the percentage of handicap and recommendation that he/she shall be able to prosecute studies in the courses offered in Engineering Schools/Polytechnics shall have to be submitted along with the application form and original shall be verified at the time of reporting in the Institution. The candidates having 40% disability and above, as approved by competent authority will be considered under the seats reserved for PH candidates. If any

candidate fails to produce such certificates from the CDMO along with physically handicapped identity card issued by District Social Welfare Officer (DSWO) along with the application form and on the day of reporting, then his / her case will not be taken into consideration under PH reservation.

- xiv. Candidates applying for OL category shall have to submit photocopies of certificate in prescribed proforma given in **Form-III** along with mark sheet of M.E. or 10th in support of having Oriya as a subject at M.E. or 10th examination along with the application form and original shall be verified at the time of reporting in the Institution.
- xv. Candidates applying under SPORTS reservation shall have to submit original SPORTS certificate issued / countersigned by Director of Sports and Youth Services, Orissa or any competent authority as declared by Govt. from time to time at the time of reporting. Such candidates must have participated in the Sports Events for the State within two (2) years time prior to the year of admission vide G.O. No.81376, dt.11.12.1996, Govt. of Orissa and letter No.24875, dt.31.12.1983 and as per clarification received from Govt. from time to time.

- xvi. Candidates applying under NCC reservation must submit original NCC A or B or C certificate from competent authority at the time of reporting.
- xvii. As per G.O. No.20555/I, dt.04.09.1995, 15% of seats in each category is reserved for Women students in each category of all the Govt. & Private co-education Polytechnics and Engineering Schools for admission.

xviii. Admission under Tuition fee Waiver Scheme

- a) The scheme shall be mandatory for all Institution approved by the AICTE.
- b) 5 % of the sanction intake per course shall be available for these admissions. These seats shall be supernumerary in nature.
- c) Sons and daughters of parents whose annual income is less than Rupees 2.5 Lakhs from all sources shall only be eligible for seats under this scheme.
- d) The waiver is limited to the Tuition Fee as notified by Government. Accordingly the eligible candidate may select the option **Yes**.
- xix. In respect of any other matter relating to admission, the decision of the DET Committee 2011 shall be final.

1.3 FEE STRUCTURE:

1. Besides this, the migration fee @ Rs.25/- shall be charged for the new entrant, if he/she is from other Boards/ Council. Besides, for examinations etc. fees as charged by the State Council shall have to be paid by the candidates later.

HOSTEL FACILITIES (Government Institutions)

Limited hostel facilities are provided subject to vacancy to the Boys in Co-educational Govt. Engineering Schools/ Polytechnics and Women students in UGIE, Rourkela, BOSE, Cuttack. Besides, limited seats in Women's hostels are also available in all Govt. Women's' Polytechnics. **At present Hostel Fees @ Rs.2500/- (Rupees Two thousand five hundred) per annum shall be charged as per the Orders of the Government from time to time.**

1.4 MERIT LIST:

a) S-Domicile:

Separate merit list for all qualifying candidates shall be drawn on the basis of DET, 2011 results in the following manner.

- i) One "General Merit List" for all candidates seeking admission to Diploma Engineering / Technology courses on the basis of marks obtained in Mathematics & General Science (Physics & Chemistry).
- ii) In addition, Separate Merit Lists will also be drawn for candidates qualifying under each of the reservation categories.
- iii) Similarly a merit list will be drawn for lateral admission category for ITI / +2 Science with Vocational candidates for admission against 80% of Total Intake.
- iv) A separate merit list will be drawn for Lateral Admission for +2 Science with PCM for admission against 20% of Total Intake.
- v) Seats remaining vacant in Food Tech. after exhausting the entire merit list of Women candidates shall be filled up from general Merit List of Male candidates as per G.O. No.10332/I, dt.27.05.2005.

b) OS- Domicile:

Separate merit list will be drawn for outside State Candidates. 15% seats are reserved for **OS** candidates effective from 2010-11 vide **G.O. No.IXTTI-8/2009 / 4624/I, Dt.26.03.2010**, which is applicable to **Private Polytechnics** only. They are not eligible for admission to 3rd semester lateral entry courses.

c) OL- Domicile:

Separate merit list will be drawn for **OL** candidates for admission to seats reserved for them. However they will also be included in the merit list of **OS** category. They are not eligible for admission to 3rd semester lateral entry courses.

N.B. : Each successful candidate of all categories shall be given a rank card.

1.5 Change of Branch & Transfer

- A student admitted into a particular institution/ course cannot be allowed to change his/her branch in the 1st year. However, such change of branches may be allowed by the Principal of a particular institution at the 3rd semester level after duly notifying the vacancies at the institution level, depending on the mark of the 1st semester examination conducted by the SCTE&VT, Orissa in order of merit.
- Students admitted in TFW scheme shall not be allowed to change Institute / Course under any circumstances as per AICTE guideline.
- Change of institution, depending on the vacant seats may be considered by the DTE&T at the 3rd / 5th semester level only from one Government institution to another Government institution or from one Private Institution to another Private institution subject to availability of vacancy, as per rule prescribed by SCTE&VT, Bhubaneswar. This should depend upon NOC of both the institution & discretion of the DTE&T.
- Transfer from one institution to another institution at higher semester in the same branch can only be undertaken at the discretion of DTE&T/ Government subject to availability of vacancy.
- A candidate so admitted shall have to maintain discipline in the institute/hostel premises and will abide by all the prescribed rules / procedure/ orders for which he/she shall have to furnish an under taking at the time of admission. In case he/she is found to be involved in ragging / misbehaving fellow junior students then he/she will be suitably punished including fine / suspension from one or more semester / issue of Compulsory T.C.
